

**Rules and Regulations hereunto annexed, or that may be hereafter adopted by the Portage Township Trustee.**

1. All interments in lots shall be restricted to relatives of the proprietor except when special permission to the contrary has been obtained from the Trustee.
2. Concrete and/or steel vaults are mandatory and are not permitted to overlap or interfere with another lot.
3. Cremated remains must be placed in a container suitable for inurnment and approved by the Trustee.
4. All improvements, or corner stones, indicating the boundaries of lots, must be placed on the lot itself, and no fences of wood, iron, or walls, curbing or brick, stone, or marble can be erected on lots.
5. The proprietor may erect any proper memorial thereon with the following limitations: The memorial shall not extend beyond the limits of the lot or lots owned by the proprietor. Memorials shall be placed at ground level on a concrete foundation adequate to the size of the memorial with the foundation extending six inches in each direction beyond the size of the memorial. This will prevent weeds from growing around the memorial. All flush markers (ground level) will have a recessed concrete foundation under the marker.
6. If any memorial, structure, or inscription placed in or upon any lots is determined by the Trustee to be offensive or improper, the Trustee shall have the right, and it shall be his duty, to enter such lot and remove the said offensive or improper object or objects; provided, however, that if said structure or improvement shall have been made with the consent of the Trustee, the same shall not thereafter be removed, except with the consent of the owner thereof.
7. The Cemetery is not responsible for anything of a moveable character placed upon the lot or lots.
8. Planting of flowers is limited to on or within six inches of the foundation line for each lot.
9. If any tree or shrub, situated in any lot, shall, by means of its roots or branches be dangerous or inconvenient to the adjacent lots, walks, or avenues, the Trustee shall have the right and it shall be his duty, to enter upon said lot and remove said tree or shrub, or such parts thereof as he may deem detrimental, dangerous, or inconvenient. Trees and shrubs may not exceed three foot in height.
10. Visitors are reminded that the Cemetery is a sacred place. Quiet and reverence must be observed at all times. The proprietors of lots, then family and friends, shall be allowed access to the grounds during normal visiting hours.
11. No driving faster than a walk will be allowed. Vehicles of all kinds must be kept off the grass. Automobile radios or other noise producing devices must be turned off or turned down so that the sound cannot be heard outside of the vehicle or within twenty feet thereof.
12. Dogs and other pets are not allowed, except when confined to a motor vehicle.
13. All Persons are prohibited from plucking any flower, either wild or cultivated, breaking or injuring any tree, plant, or shrub, or in any way injuring any memorial, vault, ornament, or other structure or property in the Cemetery. Vandalism will result in prosecution.
14. All persons are prohibited from hunting, fishing, or discharging any firearms or fireworks, or other missile, within, into or over any portion of the Cemetery property.
15. No person will be allowed to disturb the quiet or good order of the Cemetery in anyway, and the sexton and employees in the Cemetery are instructed to see that proper decorum is maintained at all times.
